

GOCO to provide up to \$3M to CPW to regrant to new and existing coalitions.

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STATEWIDE PLANNING

GOCO to fund up to \$1.4M for consultant team to assist in development of Statewide Plan.



CO-OP OPERATIONS INVESTMENT

GOCO funds up to \$100,000 to operationalize this key stakeholder advisory body.



CPW CAPACITY INVESTMENTS

GOCO funds up to \$500,000 to increase capacity at CPW for timely execution of deliverables.
